Child Protection - Please note that this Policy is updated each year and a copy can be found on the School web-site or a hard copy can be requested from the office.

We in Knocknagor P.S. have a responsibility for the safeguarding and child protection of the children in our care and we will carry out this duty by providing a caring, supportive and safe environment, where each child is valued for his or her unique talents and abilities, and in which all our young people can learn and develop to their full potential. All staff, teaching and non-teaching should be alert to the signs of possible abuse and should know the procedures to be followed. Our Child Protection Policy sets out guidance on the action, which is required where abuse or harm to a child is suspected and outlines referral procedures within our school.

The main role of the team is to:

- Monitor and periodically audit the safeguarding and child protection arrangements in the school
- Identify any actions required to address audit findings or ETI inspection of its safeguarding/child protection arrangements
- Provide support for the Designated and Deputy Designated teachers in the exercise of their child protection responsibilities.

School and ECO Council: The elections have taken place and new school councillors have been elected and are ready to take up office for this academic school year. We congratulate all pupils elected and wish them well for their busy year ahead as they bring forward pupil ideas to Mrs McGuigan and Mr Cunningham. Certificates and badges will be presented to all councillors.

Data Collection Forms / Voluntary Contributions: Thank you to all of our parents who contributed to the voluntary donation to enable us to provide extra opportunities for the children during the year. Anybody who still has to leave their forms back can send them in to their class teacher this week. PE for children in P1 – P4 will take place every Tuesday. Matthew McConkey will be doing sessions aimed at developing the children's Fundamental Movement Skills.

Seesaw: We will begin using 'Seesaw' from Thursday 1st of October with all classes. All individual login passwords and information leaflets will be given to all children.

Quick Start Guide for Students

Children should download the Seesaw Class app (free) or visit Seesaw.me

Choose I'm a Student.

Enter the home learning code received from the teacher into the Text Code box at the bottom of the screen.

Once logged in, check the Journal view on the left hand side of your screen to see if your teacher has assigned work to you. If the work you have been assigned doesn't show up here, click the Activities tab. Click +Add Response to work on the activity. Press the green tick to submit your work when you are finished.

If your teacher hasn't assigned a task within Seesaw but has asked you to take a photo of some work you have complete for example press +Add button. Choose which format of work you want to add.

Check the Inbox to see if you have any announcements from your teacher.

Students sign out by clicking on their name/avatar in the top left hand corner of the screen, then click the cog and then sign out.
